Diplomato in Fagotto, Composizione e Musica Elettronica presso il Conservatorio "G. Verdi" di Milano, ha perfezionato gli studi strumentali con i maestri O. Danzi e K.O. Hartmann.

La sua intensa attività concertistica lo ha visto collaborare in Italia e all'estero, sia in ambito sinfonico sia cameristico, come professore d'orchestra e solista al fianco di prestigiose formazioni (tra cui l'Orchestra RAI e Angelicum di Milano, Orchestra OFSI, OSL, ecc.).

Parallelamente alla carriera esecutiva, porta avanti una ricca produzione compositiva specializzata in musiche per formazioni cameristiche, orchestre di fiati e fiabe musicali.

I suoi lavori sono eseguiti a livello nazionale anche da importanti ensemble e solisti, e sono pubblicati da note case editrici del settore come Edizioni Musicali Wicky, Sonitus Edizioni e Da Vinci Edition.

All'attività artistica affianca, come insegnante, un profondo impegno nella formazione musicale delle nuove generazioni.
